this book will provide a thematic overview of one of european history s most devastating famines the great finnish famine of the 1860s in 1868 the nadir of several years of worsening economic conditions 137 000 people approximately 8 of the finnish population perished as the result of hunger and disease the attitudes and policies enacted by finland s devolved administration tended to follow european norms and therefore were often similar to the colonial practices seen in other famines at the time what is distinctive about this catastrophe in a mid nineteenth century context is that despite finland being a part of the russian empire it was largely responsible for its own governance and indeed was developing its economic political and cultural autonomy at the time of the famine finland s great famine 1856 68 examines key themes such as the use of emergency foods domestic and overseas charity vagrancy and crime emergency relief works and emigration

this highly interdisciplinary book studies historical famines as an interface of nature and culture it will bring together researchers from the natural and social sciences as well as the humanities with reference to recent interdisciplinary concepts disaster studies vulnerability studies environmental history it will examine how the dominant opposition of natural and cultural factors can be overcome such an integrated approach includes the archives of nature as well as archives of man it challenges deterministic models of human environment interaction

and replaces them with a dynamic historicising approach as a result it provides a fresh perspective on the entanglement of climate and culture in past societies

internationally the case of early modern sweden is noteworthy because the state building process transformed a locally dispersed and sparsely populated area into a strongly centralized absolute monarchy and european empire at the beginning of the 17th century this anthology provides fresh insights into the state building process in sweden during this transitional period many far reaching administrative reforms were carried out and the swedish state developed into a prime example of the early modern powerstate the contributors approach sweden s rise to greatness from the point of view of personal agency in early modern studies agency has long remained in the shadow of the study of structures and institutions this novel approach enables us to expose the difficulties setbacks and false steps that the administration had to deal with state building was a more diversified and personalized process than has previously been assumed numerous individuals were also crucially important actors in the process and that development itself was not straightforward progression at the macro level but was intertwined with lower level actors each chapter in this volume employs partially different methods depending on the source material and subject this means that both qualitative and quantitative material is combined different ways of making sense of it i e research traditions are brought together and a multi method design is used in analyzing source material one of the central methods is the systematic use of previous biographical research we want to give the individuals and their actions under discussion a background that reflects the contemporary structures of individual life cycles with the existing biographical research it is possible to create a comprehensive set of data that provides the general outlines of individual lives or the career tracks of various estates or social groups and even to construct collective biographies of certain groups

nordic homicide in deep time draws a unique and detailed picture of developments in human interpersonal violence and presents new findings on rates patterns and long term changes in lethal violence in the nordics conducted by an interdisciplinary team of criminologists and historians the book analyses homicide and lethal violence in northern europe in two eras the 17th century and early 21st century similar and continuous societal structures cultural patterns and legal cultures allow for long term and comparative homicide research in the nordic context reflecting human universals and stable motives such as revenge jealousy honour and material conflicts homicide as a form of human behaviour enables long duration comparison by describing the rates and patterns of homicide during these two eras the authors unveil continuity and change in human violence where and when did homicide typically take place who were the victims and the offenders what where the circumstances of their conflicts was intimate partner homicide more prevalent in the early modern period than in present times how long a time elapsed from violence to death were homicides often committed in the context of other crime the book offers answers to these questions among others comparing regions and eras we gain a unique and empirically grounded view on how state consolidation and changing routines of everyday life transformed the patterns of criminal homicide in nordic society the path to pacification was anything but easy punctuated by shorter crises of social turmoil and high violence the book is also a methodological experiment that seeks to assess the feasibility of long duration standardized homicide analysis and to better understand the logic of homicide variation across space and over time in developing a new approach for extending homicide research into the deep past the authors have created the historical homicide monitor the new instrument combines wide explanatory scope measurement standardization and articulated theory expression by retroactively expanding research data to the pre statistical era the method enables long duration comparison of different periods and areas based on in depth

source critique the approach captures patterns of criminal behaviour beyond the control activity of the courts the authors foresee the application of their approach in even remoter periods nordic homicide in deep time helps the reader to understand modern homicide by revealing the historical continuities and changes in lethal violence the book is written for professionals university students and anyone interested in the history of human behaviour

this book investigates the forms that the aggression and violence of peasant elites could take in early modern fennoscandia and their role within society the contributors highlight the social stratification inner divisions contradictions and conflicts of the peasant communities but also pay attention to the elite as leaders of resistance against the authorities with the formation of more centralised states the elites status and room for agency diminished but regional and temporal variations were great in this relatively drawn out process and there still remained several favourable contexts for their agency even though the peasant elite was not a homogenous entity the chapters in this collection present us one uniting feature the peasant elites tendency to assert themselves with an active and aggressive agency even if this led to very different outcomes

in the anthropocene icy environments have taken on a new centrality and emotional valency this book examines the diverse ways in which ice and humans have performed with and alongside each other over the last few centuries so as to better understand our entangled futures icescapes glaciers bergs floes ice shelves are places of paradox solid and weighty they are nonetheless always on the move unstable untrustworthy liable to collapse overturn or melt icescapes have featured indeed starred in conventional theatrical performances since at least the eighteenth century more recently the performing arts site specific or otherwise have provoked a different set of considerations of human interactions with these non human objects particularly as concerns over anthropogenic

warming have mounted the performances analysed in the book range from the theatrical to the everyday from the historical to the contemporary from low latitude events in interior spaces to embodied encounters with the frozen environment

presenting new insights into reciprocity this book combines marcel mauss s well known gift theory with barrington moore s idea of mutual obligations linking rulers and the ruled teasing out the interrelatedness of these approaches reciprocity in human societies suggests that evolutionary psychology reveals a human tendency for reciprocity and collaboration not only in a mutually cooperative way but also through increasing retributive moral emotions the book discusses various historical societies and the different models of the current welfare state nordic social democratic conservative and liberal and the repercussions of the neoliberal policies of tax havens tax cuts and austerity with a cross disciplinary approach that bridges evolutionary psychology sociology and social anthropology with history

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
